There are three groups, or families, of crocodilians: the alligatoridae, consisting of alligators and caimans; the crocodylidae, consisting of the crocodiles; and the gavialidae, made up of only the gharial, a small fish-eating cousin of the larger, buffalo-munching crocs. Across these three families are 23 different species, that have existed for more than 240 million years \u2013 that makes them 65 million years older than the dinosaurs!
