This vegetable grows to 1.4–2 m (4 ft 7 in–6 ft 7 in) tall, with arching, deeply lobed, silvery, glaucous-green leaves 50–83 cm (19 1/2 – 32 1/2 in) long. The flowers develop in a large head from an edible bud about 8–15 cm (3–6 in) diameter with numerous triangular scales; the individual florets are purple.

Botanically speaking, it belongs to the Asteraceae family and Cynara gender. The scientific name is Cynara scolymus and is cultivated mainly for its inflorescence's fleshy scales, but also for its edible floral receptacles. It is used in gastronomy (the flower's bulb) and its leaves are used therapeutically.

Modern research shows Cynara leaf extracts have antioxidative, hepatoprotective, choleric, anticholestatic, and antidyspeptic actions that include antiemetic, spasmolytic, and carminative effects. 10 A Cochrane review of C. scolymus leaf studies reported that although few rigorous clinical trials exist

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assessing Cynara leaves for cholesterol, overall beneficial effects are reported and side effects are minimal and transient. 11

Cynarin is considered one of artichoke's main biologically active chemicals. It occurs in the highest concentration in the leaves of the plant, which is why leaf extracts are most commonly employed in herbal medicine. Other documented "active" chemicals include flavonoids, sesquiterpene lactones, polyphenols and caffeoylquinic acids.

The artichoke leaves contain a number of phenolic acids, flavonoids (rutin, luteolin), cynarin and sesquiterpenes (especially caryophyllene and beta-selinene). It also contains tannins, sugar substances, inulin, mucus substances, phytosterols (taraxasterol), essential oil, provitamin A and several enzymes.

The Latin genus name Cynara derives from the Greek word kynára or kynaros, a kind of artichoke named for the Aegean Island Kinara. The species name scolymus derives from the Greek skólymus, a foreign word of unknown origin, folk-etymologically adjusted to the Greek skólop (= «pointed stake»), due to the plant's pointed thorns.
