One of the most obvious and important limitations to copyright is that it is not perpetual and expires after a set amount of time. The length of a copyright on work created during or after 1978 is the life of the author plus seventy years.

2. Limitations of Copyright - Plagiarism Today

Section 106 of the U.S. copyright law, which defines the exclusive rights in copyrighted works, is subject to sections 107 through 122, which limit the copyright holder's exclusive rights. In the U.S. in stark contrast to those copyright laws which have developed from English law, edicts of government are not subject to copyright, including edicts of foreign governments.

Duration of copyright. Copyright protection starts as soon as a work is created, for a fixed term. Copyright in literary, dramatic, musical and artistic work usually extends until 70 years after the creator's death. The standard term of copyright in sound recordings is 50 years from the year of creation or of publication. Copyright in a typographical arrangement expires 25 years after the year of publication....

Copyright and related rights

Copyright is an automatic right assigned to the creator of any piece of original work. This could be one person, multiple people or a company. Copyright allows the owner to control how their work is used. A copyright owner has the exclusive right to copy, distribute, perform, broadcast or adapt a work. Anyone who wants to reproduce copyrighted work must seek permission from the copyright holder, or check whether the owner has permitted particular use through a licence.

Crown Copyright will last for a period of 125 years from the end of the calendar year in which the work was made. If the work was commercially published within 75 years of the end of the calendar year in which it was made, Crown copyright will last for 50 years from the end of the calendar year in which it was published. The following limits also generally apply to anyone making a copy: Books: the Copyright Act permits an individual to copy one chapter or up to 5% of a work. The Library Scanning Service for Academic Staff offers copying of up to 10% under the terms of the Copyright Licencing Agency licence. This provides compliant scans of course items for student groups via secure online learning environments (for example, Moodle).
