Equine odontoclastic tooth resorption and hypercementosis are problems that have recently been recognized in older horses. The problems cause pain in the incisors, halitosis, overproduction of saliva, gum inflammation, and changes in behavior. The cause is not known, and extraction of the incisors may be the only effective treatment.

Horses don't chew using an up and down motion like humans. They use a circular grinding motion that can wear down their teeth unevenly. The resulting pointy teeth need to be filed down, or "floated," to avoid problems such as mouth sores, difficulty chewing, and injuries to other horses during play. #3 - There are no nerves inside the teeth
