Aboriginals have shorter life expectancies—about 10-15 years shorter, to be specific—and are six times more likely to commit suicide than non-Indigenous Australians. Even newborns are four times as likely to die before their first birthdays. In Wilcannia, the average boy's life expectancy is only 37 years.

Subsistence is the state or fact of subsisting (the fact of living on minimum survival levels).
