Newborn Care and Development 101 - What to Expect

Your newborn will depend on you for every aspect of her care. This section provides guidelines for some basic care activities. **BATHING** For the first year of life, your baby will only need to be bathed every 2-3 days. Sponge baths are a good way to help you and your baby become accustomed to the new routine.

A Guide to Caring for your Newborn

Feed your baby as often as they want. This is called baby-led feeding. Let your baby decide when they have had enough. Find out more about: **Breastfeeding:** the first few days. Soothing sore or cracked nipples. How to tell if your baby is getting enough milk. Washing and bathing your new baby. You do not need to bathe your baby in the first few days.

Although sudden infant death syndrome (SIDS) is rare, there are some simple precautions you can take to help reduce the risks: Always place your baby on their back – in the feet-to-foot position (feet at the foot of the cot) – when you put them down to sleep. Don ' t let your baby get too hot.

Umbilical cord care Shortly after birth, the midwife will clamp your baby's umbilical cord with a plastic clip, close to the belly button. An important aspect of newborn baby care in the 1 st month is caring for the umbilical cord stump. Give bath 2-6 hours after birth with lukewarm water in a healthy newborn. Keep the navel area clean and dry. Keep the baby ' s diaper folded down so that the stump can dry.
