Position 1 - used to manually wind your watch. Position 2 - Quickset, used to quickly move the hour hand as well as the date (24-Hour Hand doesn't move) Position 3 - used to set the minute hand and 24-Hour Hand (Hour hand moves as well but ignore that for the moment) First you need to check that the date is displayed correctly on your Rolex Explorer II and, if not, set it by pulling the crown out to the first stop (Position 2 in the animated GIF on the left) and turning it until you have the ...
