Since source scholarship began in the eighteenth century, researchers have suggested passages from "Naufragium" ("The Shipwreck"), one of the colloquies in Erasmus's Colloquia Familiaria (1518), [a] and Richard Eden 's 1555 translation of Peter Martyr's De orbo novo (1530).

Sources. The plot of The Tempest is original to Shakespeare but there are of course many influences and inspirations at work. A shipwreck in Bermuda. Shakespeare's imagination was inspired by the shipwreck described in William Strachey's letter of 1610. In the same year, Sylvester Jourdain published A Discovery of the Bermudas. Jourdain had been with Strachey on the ship as it was driven off-course and shipwrecked in Bermuda, and his account exerted its influence on Shakespeare too.
