Recommendations on the treatment of malaria reflect guidelines agreed by UK malaria specialists. If the infective species is not known, or if the infection is mixed, initial treatment should be as for falciparum malaria with quinine, atovaquone with proguanil hydrochloride, or Riamet® (artemether with lumefantrine).

Atovaquone-Proguanil: FDA-approved in 2000, atovaquone-proguanil (Malarone) is a combination drug that is used for the prevention and treatment of uncomplicated chloroquine-resistant P. falciparum malaria. It is given orally at the same time each day with food or milk to prevent nausea and vomiting.

Chloroquine is the preferred treatment for any parasite that is sensitive to the drug. But in many parts of the world, the parasites that cause malaria are resistant to chloroquine, and the drug is no longer an effective treatment. Other common antimalarial drugs include: Combination of atovaquone and proguanil (Malarone)

**Malaria – Diagnosis and treatment – Mayo Clinic**  
Artemisinin combination therapy (ACT) – used for malaria without complications. Atovaquone-proguanil – used for malaria without complications. Quinine – used for malaria without complications, and severe malaria, where it can be given straight into a vein rather than as a tablet. You may also take doxycycline or clindamycin with quinine.
