Only 17 percent of polling places were fully accessible to people with disabilities in 2017. If disabled people in the United States voted at the same rate as nondisabled voters, an estimated 2.3 million more votes would be cast, according to Barbarin and Vote for Access.

Mail-In Voting Must Be Made Accessible to Disabled Voters

As it stands, voters with disabilities that affect either their vision or mobility need assistance to cast a by-mail ballot. Voters with disabilities can choose someone to assist them or can request assistance from a county Multipartisan Assistance Team.
