Kidney cancer, also called renal cancer, is one of the most common types of cancer in the UK. It usually affects adults in their 60s or 70s. It is rare in people under 50. It can often be cured if it's found early. But a cure will probably not be possible if it's diagnosed after it has spread beyond the kidney.

Kidney cancer usually only affects one kidney. It is very uncommon for cancer to be in both kidneys. There are different types of kidney cancer. About 8 out of 10 (80%) kidney cancers are renal cell cancers (RCC). They may also be called renal cell carcinomas. They start in the cortex of the kidney. Kidney cancer can also start in the ureter and renal pelvis but this is rare. This information is about renal cell cancers.

Kidney cancer is a type of cancer that starts from the cells of the kidney. It is relatively rare, accounting for only 2-3 of every 100 people with cancer in Australia.
