When writing a summary of a narrative (story), use third person. ⚠️Avoid dialogue. There may be times when dialogue is the best way to convey the original meaning of a text, but in general dialogue should not be used. ⚠️ Begin the passage with information from the text.

Good Summaries!The Five Criteria

When writing a summary, try to answer the who, what, when, where, why and how of the piece, and provide a topic sentence to tell the reader the main concept, or theme, of the piece.
